



HOMEOWNERS AFFORDABILITY TAX CREDIT (HATC) SELF-DECLARATION FORM

The Homeowners Affordability Tax Credit (HATC) is a Provincial Tax Credit for homeowners to offset their school tax payable in Manitoba.

The HATC can only be claimed on a homeowner's principal residence.

If you have not received the HATC on your annual property tax bill, you may claim the credit on your Manitoba personal income tax return.
