



## HOMEOWNERS AFFORDABILITY TAX CREDIT (HATC) PRINCIPAL RESIDENCE SELF-DECLARATION FORM

The Homeowners Affordability Tax Credit (HATC) is a Provincial Tax Credit for homeowners to offset their school tax payable in Manitoba. The HATC can only be claimed on a homeowner's principal residence.

A principal residence is a single residential dwelling unit in Manitoba that is owned by an individual or their spouse or common-law partner and is the primary residence of the individual or the individual's cohabiting spouse or common-law partner.

An individual (and their spouse or common-law partner) cannot have more than one principal residence.
